

ARTIST'S GUIDE - SUBMITTING YOUR ARTWORK

Stage Two - Physical Judging

This guide is intended to help you prepare your artwork, so it is received in good order for this stage of judging.

For Stage Two the judges will be making two decisions.

- 1. If your work will be exhibited in the Royal Birmingham Society of Artists' Gallery, Birmingham, U.K.
- 2. If your work will also be chosen for the official UK (excluding Scotland) entry for the BAWW 2025 slideshow.

The decision of the judges on all matters is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

It is essential that these guidelines are closely followed so please ensure you have read these before your send your original artwork.

You may also be requested by the judges to make some adjustments to your submission. If requested, these are included in the email you received inviting you to send your original work.

Key Dates

Mounted Artwork Deadline : Friday 28th February, 2025

Judges Final Selection: 3rd and 4th March, 2025

Artists Informed: **7th March, 2025**

Key Points

- artwork should be submitted mounted but NOT framed
- wrapped in clear cellophane sheet
- have a strong backing board

Artwork Dimensions

The external dimensions are crucial as we are purchasing specific frames for these two sizes

Size 1 - External 50 x 60 cm which gives a painting area of 36×46 (with a minimum of a 7 cm wide border). Or

Size 2 - External 40 x 50 cm which gives a painting area of 26 x 36 cm (with a minimum of a 7cm wide border).



Figure 1. Artwork mount dimensions.

Note: Borders can be wider than 7cm but the external dimensions of the mount must be either $50 \times 60 \text{ OR } 40 \times 50 \text{ cm}$.

Mount Board

The mount board should be white or off-white and similar to either:

- Daler-Rowney Snow White (054) or
- Daler-Rowney Cumulus Cloud (404)

An acid free backing board is recommended of the same dimensions as the exterior mount board and must also be included.

All artwork chosen by the judging panel to be exhibited in the gallery will be framed and hung by the exhibition organisers using a simple light wood frame.

Packing Your Artwork

All work must arrive mounted in a flat pack. Please ensure the packaging is sufficiently robust to avoid damage during transit. It would be preferable to have packing that can be reused either to take to Birmingham and/or return to you.

Please add an extra 5 cm to the packaging dimensions to accommodate the framed artwork.

Picture boxes can be purchased online for packing and are highly recommended.

Frames will be available to purchase at cost price at the end of the exhibition. Once we have the cost of buying the frames we can let you know.

Courier Services

A number of companies in addition to Royal Mail provide courier services, including FedEx, DPD, Pack and Send, Parcel2Go, but we recommend you research the options yourself.

Insurance

You will be loaning your work to the Association of Botanical Artists for the BAWW - 2025 Exhibition so insuring your artwork is your responsibility. If you wish to insure your work you are advised to arrange insurance for the duration of the loan period including in transit.

This loan period is from when your mounted work arrives on or before **Friday 28th February 2025** until your artwork is returned.

The Association of Botanical Artists will endeavour to ensure all artworks are held securely and are handled appropriately but the Association cannot be held liable for any loss or damage for artworks whilst in transit or for the purposes of the BAWW - 2025 exhibition.

Collection of Artwork

If your work has not been sold and removed by the buyer, work can be collected in person on the takedown day from :

Sale of Artwork at the RBSA Gallery

Where you have indicated that your artwork is for sale on the original submission form, this will be added to the label in the gallery.

The Exhibition Steering Committee will NOT take a commission for any works sold either from the physical exhibition or as a result of a request from a viewing of the online digital exhibition.

If an enquiry for a commission is received by RBSA gallery staff during the exhibition or by gallery staff within 30 days after its take-down, the RBSA will charge a 10% administration fee plus standard rate VAT on that charge. If an enquiry to the RBSA is made more than 30 days after the exhibition finishes the RBSA will charge 35% commission, plus standard rate VAT on that charge.

We will have demonstrations at the the RBSA gallery by visiting artists so any support you can provide either by offering to demonstrate or assisting during the event to explain the artwork to visitors would be greatly appreciated.
